### All Contests Snowed Out

Because of the mid-April snows, the first major weekend of Cornell's spring athletic campaign was wiped out. The tennis match with Yale was postponed and will be re-scheduled. The lacrosse game scheduled for Saturday with Harvard was postponed to Wednesday, April 19 at home. Saturday's baseball game with Buffalo has been cancelled.

The Big Red baseball team will start this week's athletic activity Tuesday in a game with Colgate at Hamilton. The Varsity and Freshman golf teams will both compete at Colgate Wednesday afternoon.

The varsity baseball team plays Seton Hall Thursday on Hoy field. Friday the Freshman baseball team meets Ithaca college away.

There are eight events scheduled for Saturday. The varsity baseball team will test its skill against Princeton on Hoy field. The Varsity track team will also compete at home on Schoellkopf field against Colgate. The Varsity lacrosse team will face Dartmouth in Hanover.

Both the Freshman lacrosse and Varsity tennis teams will play at Colgate. The 150 lb. crew will face Penn at Philadelphia. The Varsity golf team will have its second match at Syracuse. Rounding out the schedule of events is the Freshman golf team's meet with Broome Tech on the Moakley course.
